Pittsburgh is a city of diverse cultures and diverse architectural styles. Downtown is filled with the juxtaposition of modern and classic buildings. During your guided walking tour, you will view everything from the historic grandeur of H.H. Richardson's stone Allegheny Courthouse to the majesty of the Union Trust Building, with its Flemish-Gothic design. From the Burke Building, one of the few surviving buildings of the great fire of 1845 to the exquisite glass PPG building, inspired by the grand public spaces of Europe. The PPG complex has 231 glass pinnacles and stands 680 feet high. The tour will wind up with lunch at one of Pittsburgh's best restaurants.
