SPEAKER BIO: Dr. Grice is currently the Chief Engineer for eServer Clusters in the eServer Systems Architecture and Design.

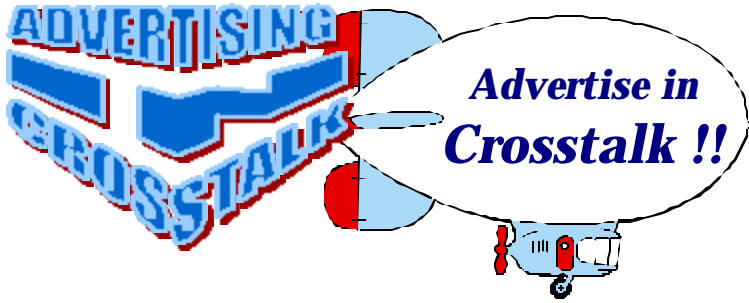
He is responsible for the architecture of the PowerPC based clusters, and the interaction of the eServer Cluster designs.
