

# Available Section Positions

**Historic Landmarks:** Responsibilities include recognizing and promoting landmarks in New Hampshire that have historical significance with respect to information and electrical technologies. Time commitment per month is approximately two to four hours.

**Publicity:** Responsibilities include putting together Section announcements and advertisements for distribution to local media including newspapers and television such as New Hampshire Public Television. Time commitment per month is approximately two hours.

**Section Functions:** Responsibilities include planning and organizing Section events such as the annual Summer Outing and Awards Banquet. Time commitment per month is approximately three to eight hours.
