2. Paper/Project idea should not have won a prize at any earlier contest.
3. Use of overhead /slide projector is permitted during presentation.
4. 15 minutes are allowed for presentation.
(10 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for question-answer session)
5. Participating students are required to submit a bonafide certificate from the Principal of his/her college.

Students' Paper/Project Contest:

A technical Paper/Project Contest for the students, encouraging them to gain in-depth knowledge of subjects of their interest, in the fields of Electrical and Electronics Engg. or allied fields.

Guidelines:

1. In-depth knowledge of the subject is expected.
2. Paper should be 10 pages or 2500 words, whichever is less.
3. Submit 3 hard copies and one soft copy of Paper. (The soft copy may be submitted either on cd or sent by email to mmshah@yahoo.com)

Format: Each paper/project must include:

1. Title of the paper/project, Name(s) of student(s), their classes, their residential address and telephone numbers & college/institute address on a separate sheet.
2. Abstract, Introduction, Main body of the paper, Conclusion, References.
3. Author(s) bio-data along with their residential address, telephone nos. and Email address on a separate sheet.
