1. PREAMBLE:

The IEEE Communications Society (ComSoc) Calcutta Chapter was formed on Oct. 13, 2003 with Prof. Debasish Saha as the Chairman and the IEEE Circuits And Systems (CAS) Society was formed on July 27, 2007 with Prof. Rabindranath Nandi as the Chairman. Since its inception, both the CAS and ComSoc Chapters have been active and organizing Educational Programs every year to cater the needs of the Local IEEE Members. The Executive Committee of CAS and ComSoc Chapters had decided to organize a Joint Educational Program (CASCOM) in 2009, as was done in 2007. Thus the CASCOM'09 Program was then finalized as a Two-day event with proposed date as March 20 & 21, 2009 with the venue being Jadavpur University (JU) Campus, Kolkata and Tata Consultancy Services (TCS), Kolkata for the Day 1 and Day 2 Programs, respectively.

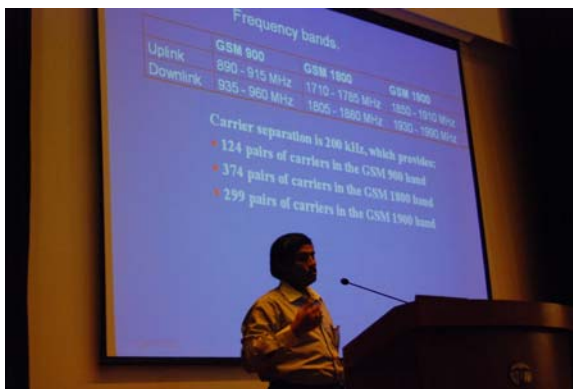

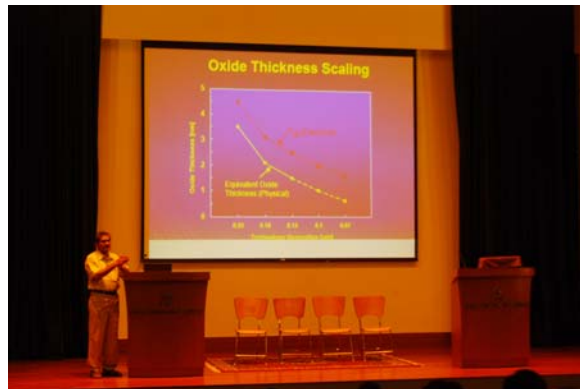
