



A. Event with Psychologist


Topic Name: "Pandemic Effect on Teenagers: How to deal with it" by Dr. Aratrika Sen






Event: Participating in the Panel Discussion in the 4th International conference on "Electronics, Materials Engineering &Nano-Technology" IEMENTech 2020.
