Powerlink owns, develops, operates and maintains Queensland's \$5.2 billion electricity transmission network. Else is one of only a few women to chair large Australian corporations, the result of a successful engineering career in the sugar, telecommunications and electricity industries.

For her contributions to engineering, education and the electricity industry, Else was awarded a Member of the Order of Australia (AM) in 2003. She also received a Centenary Medal in 2003 for services to Australia in the field of information technology. She is a Fellow of the Australian Academy of Technological Sciences and Engineering, and is an Honorary Fellow of Engineers Australia.
