Speaker Biography

Dr. Floyd (Ben) Cole, III is the Technical Director of the Research Directorate of the National Security Agency. A mathematician by training, Dr. Cole received his Bachelors Degree from Davidson College in North Carolina and his Masters and PhD Degrees from Rutgers University, all in the 1960's.

After serving in the US Army, he joined NSA in 1970 where he has served in numerous offices. For most of his career, Dr. Cole worked in the field of cryptology where he received many awards. He assumed his current position in 1999 leading the technical research of NSA in such disciplines as Computer Science, Engineering, Language Technologies, Mathematics, Statistics, and Physics. He is also a faculty member at the University of Maryland, College Park and Baltimore County where he is currently teaching the senior course in Algorithms. Dr. Cole is married with 3 children and 5 grandchildren.
