

The 4th Annual Florida Panhandle Regional Science Bowl competition will be held on **Saturday, February 25, 2006** at the UWF/OWC Joint Campus in Fort Walton Beach, FL. The Florida Panhandle Region includes the 10-county area in the Central Time zone. The top winning team will proceed to the National Science Bowl finals during April 27 - May 1, 2006, with an all expense paid trip by the US Department of Energy and the national sponsors. The Science Bowl is a fast paced tournament-style academic competition that challenges and recognizes students' knowledge in all branches of science and mathematics, using a round robin/double-elimination format.

Each high school should register their teams at this time. Teams will be registered on a first-come basis. To register, please complete all the Team Forms (team, student medical, parent consent, and coach medical) and mail it to Dr. Maqsood Mohammed, P.O.Box 1935, Eglin AFB, FL 32542, so that it is received by **February 10, 2006**.
