**TOPIC:** “Investigating Paranormal Mysteries” w/ Joe Nickell ([www.joenickell.com](http://www.joenickell.com))



Joe Nickell has been called a “modern day Sherlock Holmes” and the “real-life Scully (from the *X-Files*). He is a paranormal and forensic investigator of mysteries, myths and hoaxes. He approaches every investigation with an open and rational mind. He is the world’s only full-time professional paranormal investigator and a frequent writer for *Skeptical Inquirer*, as well as an established author and senior fellow at the Center for Skeptical Inquiry. He travels the world utilizing his unique background as a former magician, private investigator and academic. In his talk, Joe will focus on paranormal investigations from his own “X-files”, including reports of ghost hauntings, sea monsters and little green men. This presentation is given at The Putnam Museum, in Davenport, Iowa, in conjunction with their “The Science of Ghost Hunting” exhibit. Joe will explain that most ghost hunting, in his experience, employs pseudoscience, and he will explore why we are susceptible to being fooled by our own senses when we come across something “unexplained”. IEEE is sponsoring this event together with The Putnam Museum in order to both entertain a diverse audience, and to instill the importance of critical thinking when it comes to the “paranormal” or our everyday lives.
