

## **Noyce Teaching Fellows Program - Trinity University**

The **Noyce Teaching Fellows** program at Trinity University addresses the teacher shortage in the critical need areas of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM). The Noyce Teaching Fellows program is funded through assistance by the National Science Foundation and recruits working professionals with an academic degree in a STEM field. **Fellows receive a full cost-of-attendance scholarship to attend Trinity's nationally-recognized, one-year teacher certification program.** They also receive a \$12,000 stipend annually during their four-year commitment in the classroom.

Trinity University is seeking to reach interested candidates in or near the San Antonio area.
