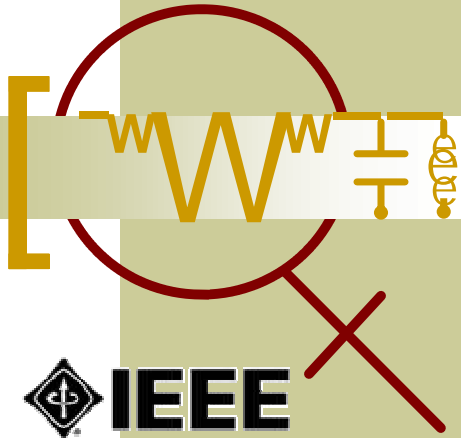

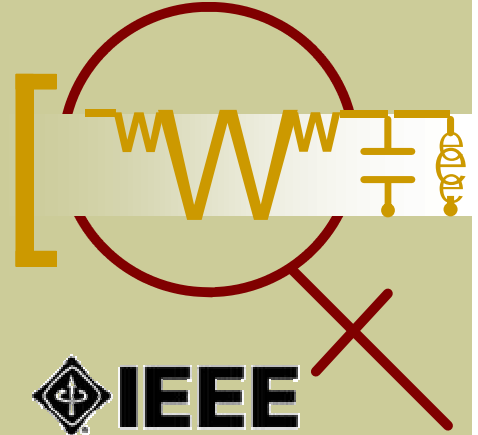

MISSION OF WOMEN IN ENGINEERING SANTA CLARA VALLEY

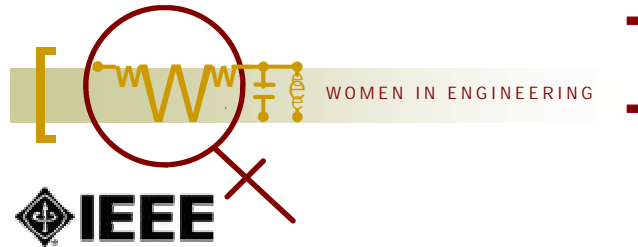
WIE is dedicated to promoting and supporting women members of the IEEE at both the professional and student level. We share our enthusiasm in science and engineering through:
