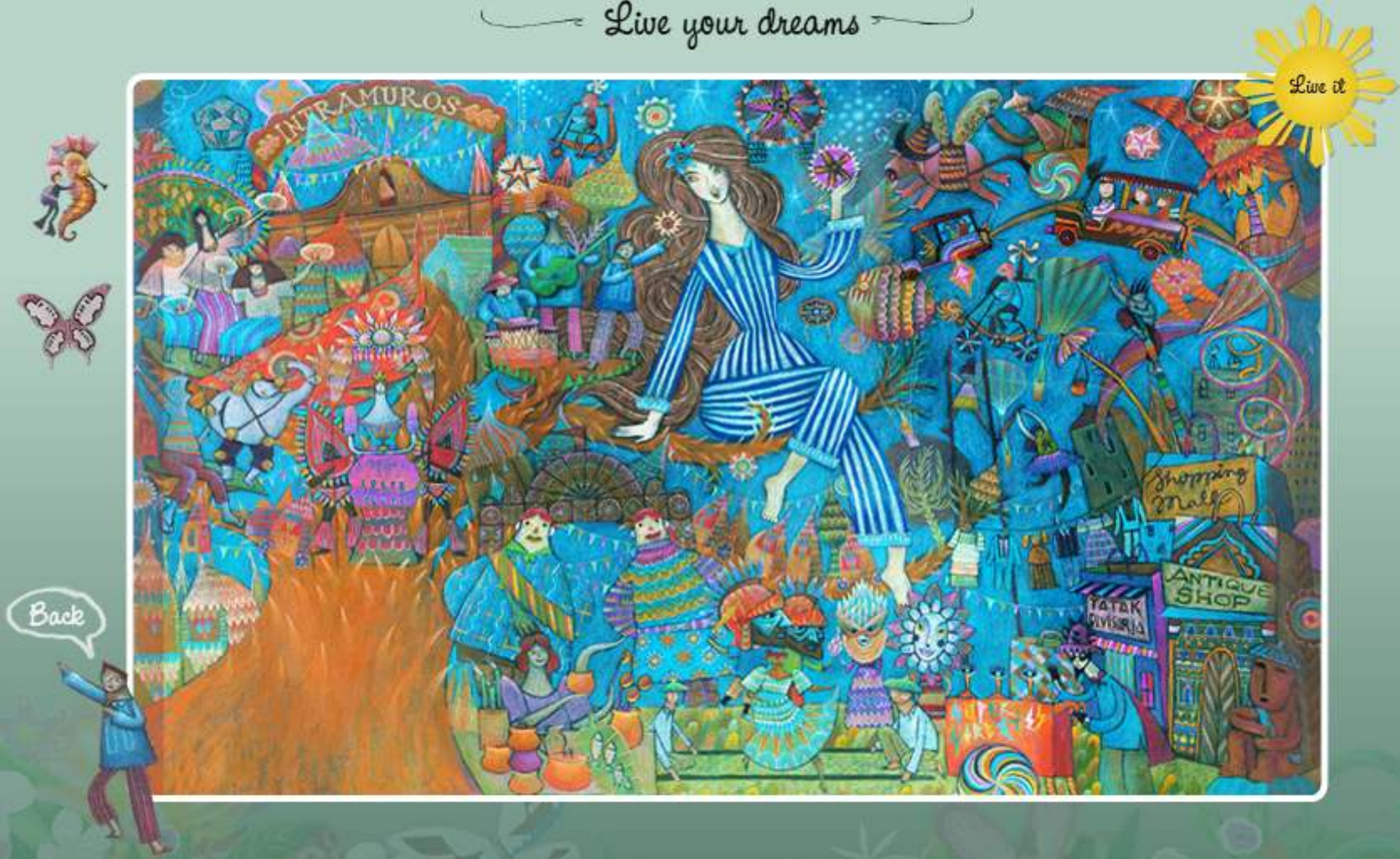

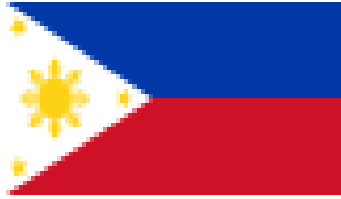

# About Cebu

- History

- Before the arrival of the Spaniards, Cebu (Zubu or Sugbo) was a trading post with trade routes to Borneo, Indonesia, China and Arabia.
- On September 20, 1519, Ferdinand Magellan led a flotilla of five ships with a crew of 250 out of the Spanish port of San Lucar de Barrameda enroute to the Spice Islands via the Americas and Pacific Ocean.
- They reached the Philippine Archipelago on March 16, 1521. Raja Kolambu of Mazzaua in Mindanao told them to head for Cebu, where they could trade and have provisions.



# About Cebu

- Ferdinand Magellan's attempt to circumnavigate the globe ended tragically on April 27, 1521 at the Battle of Mactan.
