Globalisation of IEEE

- AdHoc Committee 2009

- Great Initiative of the IEEE President
- Good Representation of R7-10 (NT Nair and myself from R10)
- Findings: R10 gives 19% of membership (30% of S, 16% of SM, 16% of F, 15% of M), 19% of Society membership 42.5% of IEL subscribers, 50.4% of total Explore users, 33% of authors for IEEE journals -2007 Data

How well was R10 (18%) represented in IEEE Governance in 2007?

- TAB 1.7%
- PSPB 7.7%
- Standards 0%
- EAB 0%
- RAB 5.6%
- Society AdComs 10%

How Well is R10 represented in 2009?

- Well represented on 2009 IEEE AdHoc Committees!!!

 - 0/8 Memb Eng, 1/8 N&A, 2/37 SAC, 0/18 MGAB rep on other Boards.....
