Eligibility:
Participants may compete as an individual or as a team.
Individuals: Individuals who compete to IEEE Student Activities.

Different background colours to highlight the announcements.

Concerns

- Very simple website and still not attracting a large number of visitors
- Lacks as a forum for live interaction or coordination among R10 Sections and Student Branches (chat, facebook, portals, sharepoint etc)
- Based on old technology – needs to be redeveloped using new technologies such as Web 2.0
