R10 in 2008 in Brief: Membership

- 2008: 73,662, (2007: 67,157), 19% of total
- Highest growth of all Regions, 9.7%
- HGMs: 3% growth, the highest of all Rs
- Students: 21.1% growth!!!
- R10 provides 19% of Society membership and 30% of authors for IEEE periodicals



R10 in 2008 in Brief: Budget

- **Planned Budget: aggressive overspending**
- **Changed policy and attitude during the year**
- **Achieved budget: Balanced**

- (Our Region provided over 50% of usage for IEL and IEEEplore with 19% membership)

R10 in 2008 in Brief: Activities

- **Organisational Consolidation (after previous 22% growth in Section numbers)**
 - Support for new Sections from Region, Fanny and Serena and HQ (Cecilia and Matt):
 - Reactivation of defunct Student Branches (through GINI) and Sections (Karachi)

- **Outstanding Activities at many levels:**
 - 30% of MGAB Awards
