PART A – COUNCIL SUMMARY

PART A.1 - EXECUTIVE SUMMARY.

During the year, India Council fulfilled its objectives in co-ordination with sections in India, in their technical/professional activities. The committee had 3 meetings during the year to discuss various matters relating to IEEE growth in India including All India Student Congress. The Annual Conference and Exhibition (ACE 2001) was held at New Delhi in November 2001.

PART B.1 - MEMBERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME.

The study growth in membership continued in year 2001 also and same efforts will continue in 2002 also.

PART B.2 – PROFESSIONAL and CONTINUING EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES.

In addition to its joint sponsorship programmes with sections, societies and chapters, IC chapters organize a number of workshops and conferences on relevant topics. Its main conference (ACE 2001) was held at New Delhi.

Though the sections directly report to REP Co-coordinators, the India Council continued to encourage the progress in this area.

The second All India student Congress was held at Mumbai in March 2001. More number of student branches have been opened in 2001.

The Home page of India Council is being maintained & updated. More & more members are going to have e-mail, thereby facilitating the communication amongst themselves. Newsletter of India Council is being published regularly every month and distributed to all the members in India.

All the Chapters, directly under India council are very active in their technical activities.
