#### **A.1 Executive Summary**

- Section activity : A number of activities were organized during 2001 by the Nagoya Section. Total 19 events including 16 lectures in the areas of computer, communication, electric power, material development, automobile electronics and control engineering were successfully carried out. In particular as special program, we had 6 seminars for young researchers and school students.
- Membership activity : Nagoya Section has the following members ; Fellow :23, Senior Members:26, Member: 580, Associate members:105, Student members:52, Total:812.
