A\$10k in seed capital.

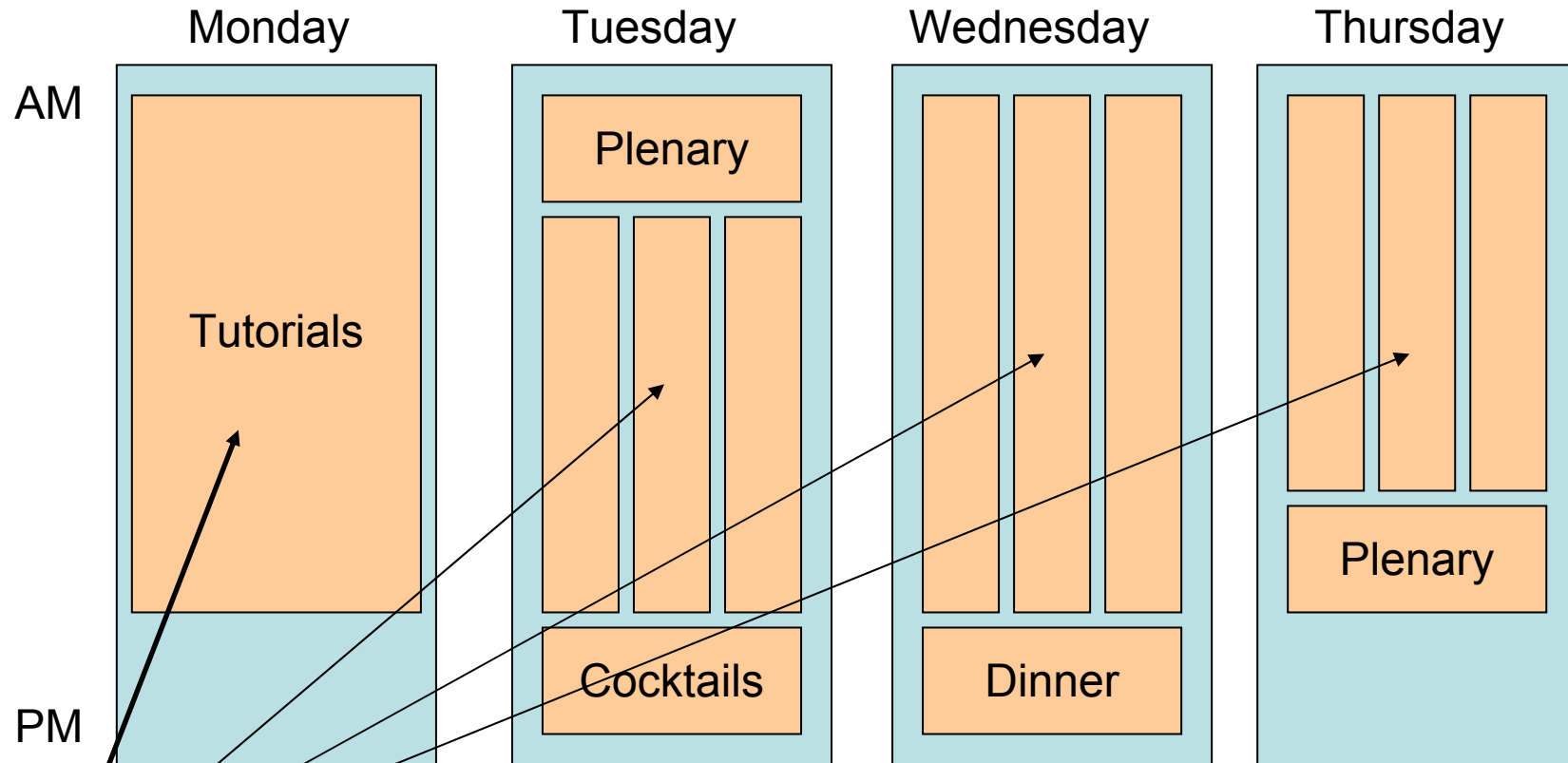


About The Venue (MECC)
