# MGA Awards

## ■ MGA Outstanding Large/Small Section Awards

### **Purpose**

The MGA Outstanding Large Section Award will be awarded to one Large Section to recognize the excellent work of the Section in the past year. The total membership of a Large Section (including Students) shall be 501 or greater as of 31 December of the prior year.

The MGA Outstanding Small Section Award will be awarded to one Small Section to recognize the excellent work of the Section in the past year. The total membership of a Small Section (including Students) shall be 500 or less as of 31 December of the prior year.

## ■ Achievement Award

### – PURPOSE

To recognize individuals involved with MGA and/or the Regional network for singular achievement in the development and completion of a project(s) or activity(ies) which are directed to the fulfillment of one or more of the goals and objectives of MGA. This award is designed to recognize those substantive projects or achievements of a relatively short nature (one to three years) but which have left an undeniable imprint on the fabric of regional operations.

– Nomination Deadline 15 October

# MGA Awards

## ■ Innovation Award

### – PURPOSE

- To recognize the accomplishment judged to be the most innovative and effective in fulfilling one or more of the goals and objectives of MGA.
- The accomplishments of the candidate should be of "significant performance," and have made a distinguishing contribution to IEEE.
- Deadline **15 October**

## ■ Leadership Award

### – PURPOSE

To recognize those individuals who have exhibited exemplary and substantive leadership of an extraordinary nature in implementing activities which support MGA goals and objectives at the local, regional, national, and/or international level.

## ▣ **Larry K. Wilson Transnational Award**

### – **PURPOSE**

To recognize the accomplishment judged to be the most significant and effective in fulfilling one or more of the transnational goals and objectives of MGA as related to Transnational activities. This award is made in memory of Dr. Larry K. Wilson.

# MGA Awards

## ■ **GOLD ACHIEVEMENT AWARD**

- This award is designed to recognize those substantive projects or achievement of a relatively short nature (one to three years) but which have left an undeniable imprint on the fabric of GOLD operations.
- The award will be based on a selection that recognizes individuals involved with GOLD activities who are recognized for singular achievement in the development and completion of a project(s) or activity(ies) which are directed to the fulfillment of one or more of the GOLD goals and/or objectives.
- The individuals nominated must be GOLD members at the time of nomination.
- **Nomination Deadline 15 October**

- **Friend of IEEE Member and Geographic Activities Award**
- The Friend of IEEE Member and Geographic Activities Award was created to specifically recognize support provided to the IEEE and its members in support of its goals by firms, divisions of firms or individuals.

# IEEE-USA AWARDS

## Professionalism

- [Robert S. Walleigh Distinguished Contributions to Engineering Professionalism Award](#) — To honor members of the engineering profession for long-term dedicated effort and outstanding accomplishments in advancing the aims of IEEE professional activities in the United States.
- [Award for Distinguished Public Service](#) — To honor individuals not currently in the practice of engineering for contributions to furthering the professional goals of IEEE in the United States. (These goals may be furthered by such means as promulgating laws or regulations benefiting the profession; influencing industrial environments to foster professionalism; creating curricula or publications designed to enhance professionalism; and other similar activities.)

## Professionalism

- [Citation of Honor](#) — To honor members who have made exemplary contributions toward achieving the aims of professional activities in the United States.
- [Precollege Education Committee Teacher-Engineer Partnership Award](#) — To recognize collaborative activities between K-12 teachers and technical professionals who are IEEE members.

# IEEE-USA AWARDS

## Professionalism

- [Regional/Divisional Professional Leadership Award](#) — To recognize members for their outstanding leadership efforts in advancing the professional aims of IEEE within their Regional or Divisional entities.
- [Professional Achievement Award](#) — To recognize significant specific contributions, achievements and individual and organizational efforts in the development and implementation of professional activities in the United States.

# IEEE-USA AWARDS

## Technical Achievement

- [Harry Diamond Memorial Award](#) — To honor individuals for distinguished technical contributions in the field of electrotechnology while in U.S. Government Service.
- [Electrotechnology Transfer Award](#) — To honor individuals whose contributions in key government or civilian roles led efforts to effectively transfer/apply federal or state sponsored developments in advanced electrical, electronic and computer technologies to successful commercial sector opportunities

- [Award for Distinguished Literary Contributions Furthering Public Understanding of the Profession](#) — To recognize outstanding journalistic or other efforts that contribute to the enhancement and expansion of the public understanding of the engineering profession in the United States.
- [Award for Distinguished Literary Contributions Furthering Engineering Professionalism](#) — To recognize those individuals who have made outstanding contributions through their literary efforts to the advancement of the U.S. professional objectives of IEEE.

## Entrepreneur Achievement Award –NEW!

- Exemplifies an IEEE member who embodies the spirit of an entrepreneur. The IEEE member has demonstrated this spirit -- “creative mindset” (Faltin, 2007) -- through perseverance by using their own visionary efforts to create a successful business that has commercialized technology products or services. The IEEE member and his or her successful business have advanced society through commerce and community improvement.
