CJECE COPYRIGHT FORM – NOTES AND CONDITIONS

CJECE POLICY

The CJECE copyright policy is closely modelled on the policy of IEEE.

In connection with its publishing activities, it is the formal policy of the CJECE to own the copyrights to all copyrightable material that it publishes and to the individual contributions contained therein, in order to protect the interests of the CJECE, its authors, and their employers and, at the same time, to facilitate the appropriate reuse of this material by others. The CJECE may distribute its content by various means, such as hard copy and electronic media. It also abstracts and may translate its content for inclusion in various compendiums and similar publications. When an article is submitted for publication to the CJECE, the CJECE understands that its acceptance of the article implies that the CJECE has the rights to do all the things it normally does with such an article.

The following formal CJECE policy applies to all material submitted to the CJECE.

CLEARANCE OF PAPERS

The CJECE must of necessity assume that material submitted to it is properly available for general dissemination to the audience it is intended to serve. It is the responsibility of the authors, not the CJECE, to determine whether disclosure of their material requires the prior consent of other parties and, if so, to obtain it.

Furthermore, the CJECE must assume, if an author uses within his/her article previously published and/or copyrighted material, that permission has been obtained for such use and that any required credit lines, copyright notices, etc., are duly noted.

Obligations

In exercising its rights under copyright, the CJECE will make all reasonable efforts to act in the interests of the authors and employers as well as in its own interest. In handling third-party reprint/republication requests for a CJECE work, the CJECE requires that

1. The consent of the first-named author be sought as a condition in granting republication (of a full paper) to others.
2. The consent of the employer be obtained as a condition in granting permission to others to reuse all or portions of a paper for promotion or marketing purposes.

Author/Employer Rights

If you are employed and you prepared your paper as a part of your job, the rights to your paper initially rest with your employer. In that case, when you sign the Copyright Form, we assume you are authorized to do so by your employer and that your employer has consented to all the terms and conditions of this form. If not, the form should be signed by someone so authorized.

Please note that, although authors are permitted to reuse all or portions of their CJECE-copyrighted material in other works, this does not include granting third-party requests for reprinting, republishing, or other types of reuse. All third-party requests must be handled by the CJECE editorial office.

Joint Authorship

For jointly authored papers, have all authors sign, or at least have one of the authors sign as an authorized agent for the others. In the case of multiple authorship where one or more authors are government employees but at least one author is not, that non-government author should sign Part A of this Copyright Form.

U.S. Government Employees / U.S. Government Contract Work

Authors who are U.S. Government employees are not required to sign the Copyright Form, but any co-authors outside the government are required to sign (see "Joint Authorship" above).

Authors whose work was performed under a U.S. Government contract or grant, but who are not government employees, are required to sign Part A of this Copyright Form.
