Hardware Competition Sample Abstract Format

Project Title:

Jot down the practical implementations your project proposes or any application it could be used for. How does it supercede the already implied methods or how can one benefit by using your proposed solutions.

Background and Justification:

Write down the research work carried out in the field of your work, and propose your solution with the advancements, enhancements or innovations you've contributed to the task.

NOTE: • The abstract should not exceed THREE (3) papers of an electronic document. • Fonts should be made clear and readable, preferably of the type "Times New Roman", Size: 12.
