

## **IEEE INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS SOCIETY TRANSITIONAL GOVERNMENT**

The Transitional Government will cease to exist three years after the approval by TAB of the formation of the Society and election of the regular BOG and Officers.

**Section 1.** Officers - During the transitional period immediately following the formation of the new Society, the previously duly elected Officers of the Intelligent Transportation Systems Council shall serve as Officers of the Society, until replaced by elections. At its annual meeting in 2004, the BOG shall elect a President-Elect, Vice President for Financial Activities, Vice President for Technical Activities, and Vice President for Administrative Activities with terms to begin in January 2005. During 2005, the sitting BOG will elect the Vice President for Publication Activities, Vice President for Conference Activities, Vice President for Member Activities, and Editor-in-Chief of Transactions with terms to begin in January 2006. During 2005, the first year of the Society, there will be eight voting officers as follows:

- President
- President-Elect
- Vice President for Financial Activities
- Vice President for Publication Activities
- Vice President for Conference Activities
- Vice President for Technical Activities
- Vice President for Administrative Activities
- Editor-in-Chief of Transactions

From 2006 and on, there will be nine voting officers as stated in Article IV of the Bylaws:

- President
- President-Elect in odd-numbered years
- The Past President in even-numbered years
- Vice President for Financial Activities
- Vice President for Publication Activities
- Vice President for Conference Activities
- Vice President for Technical Activities
- Vice President for Administrative Activities
- Vice President for Member Activities
- Editor-in-Chief of Transactions

**Section 2.** Board of Governors - During the annual meeting in 2004, the thirty (30) Members of the Intelligent Transportation Systems Council AdCom, appointed by the fifteen sponsoring societies with two per society, shall elect five BOG members with a

one-year term, five BOG members with a two-year term, and five BOG members with a three-year term, to begin in January 1 of 2005.

The election of Society BOG members will be phased in as shown below. Assuming TAB approves the formation of the Intelligent Transportation Systems Society in June 2004, first BOG election will take place in 2005 for terms to begin in 2006. Thus the BOG transition is as follows:
