Technical Development Brainstorming

1. We had lots of interest in our 2000 area workshops due to the presentation that Bob Parro did on holding a DSP workshop. The sections have not picked that up and run with it. What if the region offered a speaker/topic and 6 or 8 dates this year and R4 would pay the expenses for the speaker to go to a section for a workshop or seminar and the section guaranteed 10 or more attendees. The speaker could be a distinguished speaker on a good topic or perhaps several of them on different topics. Topics could include things like Inifiniband, Project Management, e-Business, XML, Internet Security, ISO Registration, DSPs, a PACE topic or ...
