



Majordomo Email Lists



- Automates email list management
 - Got us out of database management
- Had our Website provider implement Majordomo
 - Two email lists for each local organization,
 - tc-ieee-<name> : list for members
 - tc-ieee-<name>-officers: list for organization officer
 - Monitored lists: closed for officers, open for members
 - Change list ownership each year, as officers change



Effective Email Addresses

- Extensive Use of Majordomo
- Maintain lists of Unsubscribe's
- New addresses from SAMIEEE each month
- MS Access to extract addresses with:
 - embedded @
 - no embedded spaces
 - end in com, edu, org, net, gov, mil, or 'xx'
- Delete those from Unsubscribe lists



Result



- 5188 names
- 3129 with email addresses
- 3032 with valid email addresses

Active (paid up) Members

- 3600 names
- 2553 with email addresses
- 2411 with valid email addresses

Fewer than 200 Bounces
