IEEE & Other Organizations

- Membership marketers agree the key to growth is keeping and holding members
- Longer term members don't fail to renew, Members who have recently joined are lost
- It is more cost effective to work on keeping members than to recruit new members
- Time, initiative, resources required to keep these members "on board"
- Best programs involve personal contact

Retention = Value



Going after them

- Keep the ones you have
 - After you recruit new members, don't forget them
- Best Practices Lists
 - New members at trade shows Offer to provide short talks and it may help them and you
 - Join Chamber of Commerce
 - Random Surveys of Non-Members
 - Others
- One Time vs. Continuous Efforts
 - Some volunteers will help once (at 1st)
 - Long term committees
 - Every Section must have an MD Chair!

New Section Members

- Don't wait until they are lost!
- Help new members "Welcome Kit"
- Add to Address Lists immediately
- Encourage to join local Chapter Society
- Invite/offer a first time free meal
- Special 'New to the Section' name badges
- When new members feel welcome, they are more likely to come back and get involved.
 Ignore them and they may be less likely to return



Resources: Identify/Communicate

- Membership Database (SAMleee)
 - Identify member areas/types
 - Find interests
 - Discover volunteers
- Entity Web Hosting/Functional Alias
 - Have general info area & tell them about you (include address on all correspondence)
 - Inform Members/Non-Members in Advance
- New Member Welcome Kit
 - Tells them about local sections
 - Tells them how to find you
- Much more From IEEE HQ & Others
