Access & Program Details:

Access to the 2022 14th IEEE International Memory Workshop virtual platform is available at the following link: <https://www.engagez.net/IMW2022>. To enter, you must be registered for IMW 2022. A full session listing is available under the 'Interactive Program' tab along the top menu bar when logged into the platform.

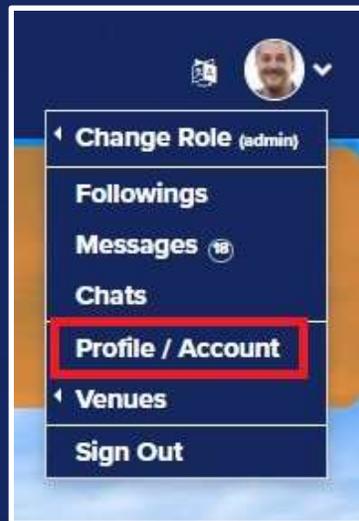
Logging in & Creating Your Profile:

The log-in screen looks like this:



To enter the virtual platform, you must use the same email address you registered with. First time virtual platform users will need to create a password. Click on "CREATE or UPDATE Password" and follow the prompts. After you have logged in to the platform, we encourage all attendees to complete their Attendee Profile. To do this, simply navigate to the top right of the screen. Locate the button with the circular head icon and associated drop down menu and select the option labeled "Profile / Account".



Review and update your profile by clicking on "Edit Profile". By adding more information to your profile, it will make it easier for colleagues and other attendees to find you, and network with you, during the workshop (whether in-person or virtually). Please set up your password and profile prior to the start of the workshop on 15 May.

Live Sessions:

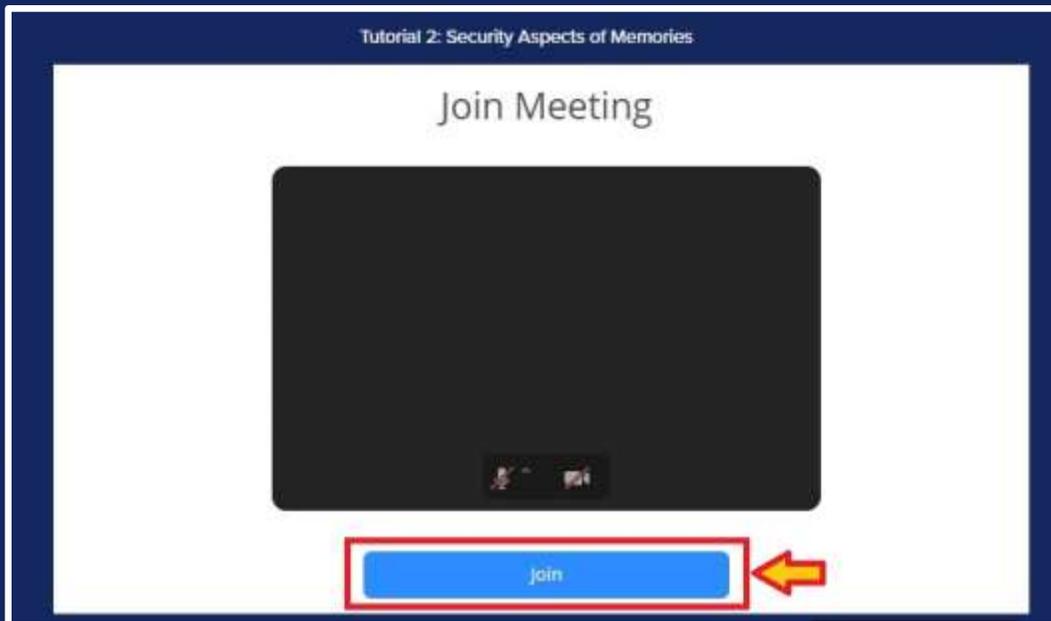
All sessions from the face-to-face event will be livestreamed and take place inside the virtual platform through an embedded Zoom meeting experience.

Navigating the Program:

- 1) Click the Interactive Program button from the top navigation menu bar.
- 2) Next, find the session you wish to attend and click the name of that session.

3) A pop-up window will appear. This is a preview of the session. It includes the session title, speakers, etc. To enter the session, click the 'Attend' button.

4) Once you are inside the session, the live Zoom meeting will play within the center of the screen's media player, like this (select 'Join'):



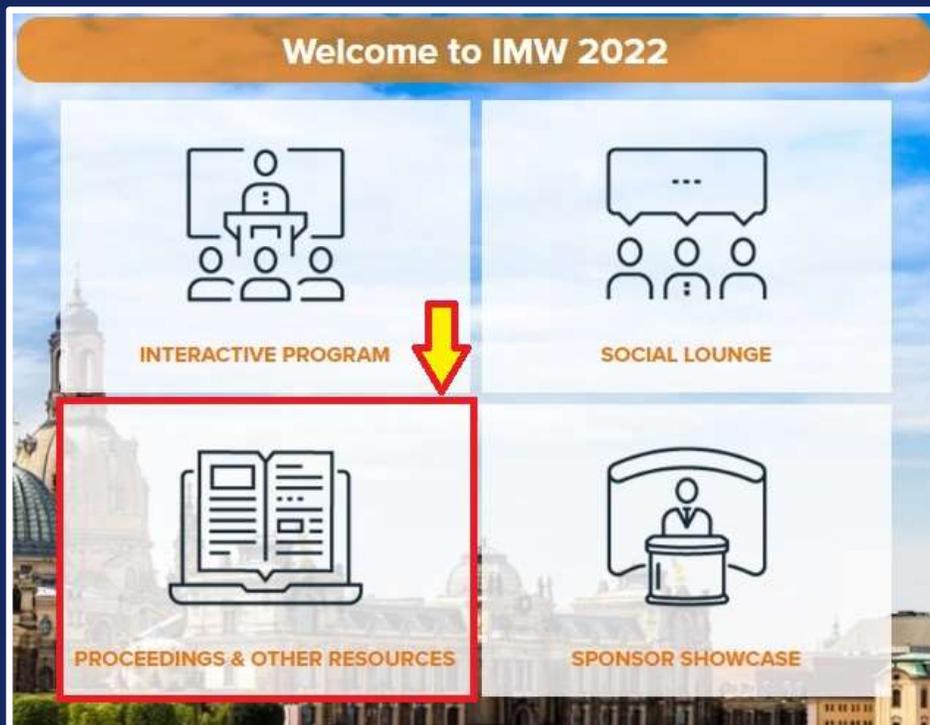
On-Demand Sessions:
