All paper submission and review requirements must be completed by June 2, 2008. These requirements are: (1) Obtaining a Paper Submission Authorization Number (see details below), (2) Electronic filing of your paper at the web site designated on the author's instruction page, (3) Your review and approval of the converted PDF file, and (4) Completion of the IEEE copyright form.

Please be aware that June 2, 2008 is a firm deadline. You are strongly encouraged to register as early as possible so that you have sufficient time to successfully complete the registration process before the deadline. Last year no papers were accepted from authors who registered after the deadline.

CONFERENCE REGISTRATON DETAILS

This year a Paper Submission Authorization Number will be required to upload papers. This number will only be issued to authors who (1) Register at the full conference or one-day rate by June 2, 2008 and (2) Enter the identification number (IAS28p7) for the papers they plan to submit on the registration form.

If a student is the ONLY registering author, then that student must register with a full or one-day regular registration, NOT a student registration. In cases where a paper has multiple authors, only one author needs to obtain a Paper Submission Authorization Number. Any of the co-authors can use the number to submit the paper. Each Paper Submission Authorization Number can be used for either one or two papers without additional charges. A charge of US\$125 per paper will be required for authors who wish to submit more than two papers using a single Paper Submission Authorization Number. The fee should be paid when registering for the conference.

Instructions for registering for the conference, making a hotel reservation, and other details will be available on the conference web site (<http://www.ieee.org/ias2008>) on or about May 1, 2008. The web

link for author instructions will lead to all relevant information and instructions for uploading your paper. You are encouraged to review the information on the upload site prior to actually beginning the upload process.

You should follow the uploading instructions carefully. Note that these instructions will indicate that papers must be prepared in standard IEEE two-column format. There is an 8 page limit on all papers. Should your paper exceed this limit, you will be assessed a charge of US\$250 per page for each page over 8 pages. This charge should be paid through the conference registration web site. If payment is not made by June 20, 2008, the overlength paper will be removed in its entirety from the conference program and proceedings.

You should be aware that paper submission will be electronic only (via the paper upload web site) and no hard copy or email attachment submissions will be accepted. As a result, it is important that the paper and copyright submission instructions on the paper upload site be read carefully and that the author checklist is utilized in order to avoid problems that could prevent us from being able to schedule your paper. Instructions for preparing your oral presentation can be found on the author's instructions page of the conference web site. Computer projection equipment will be available for presentations.
